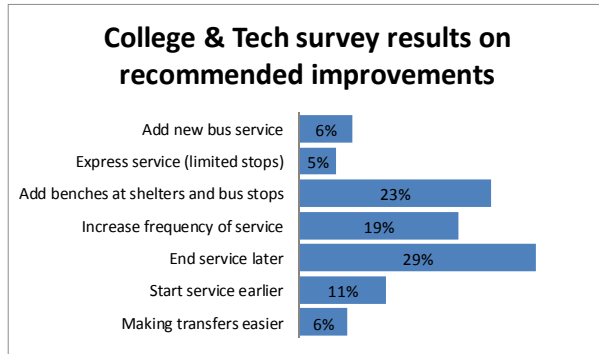

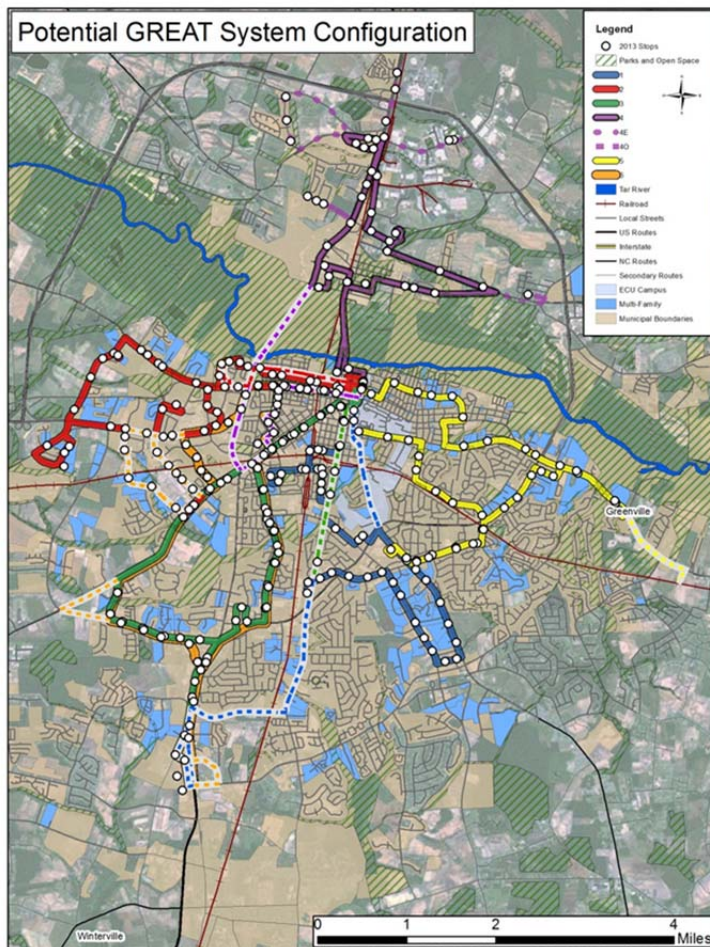
Starting at 9 a.m. the GREAT bus routing options will be displayed at the Leslie Building on the Pitt Community College Campus in Winterville.
